Greetings in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ. We thank God for the gift of life and we are pushing on well though with some sick children.

This month we got some challenges where we lost two children.

1. Mugisa Aggrey: Aggrey was estimated to be 2 ½ years who was abandoned on 31. December 2021 severely malnourished and had hypertrophies turbines. He was put on nutrition treatment. He never responded well and up to the time he passed on he was still on nutritious foods. On 25thSeptember 2022 he passed on in Buhinga Hospital, he was buried in public cemetery since he had been abandoned with no family burial took place on the 26th september2022 . grateful to Partnerschaft Gesunde Welt for helping us meet the burial costs.
2. Monica Kobugabe was just 10 days old whose mother was mentally ill and was not breastfeeding. She was brought in the home for safety since the mother could not manage taking care of her. She was very weak and after few days the whole body turned yellow and she was rushed to the hospital for more management. She could not survive because feeding was a problem and all the time she was feeling sleepy.
